If weather does not permit outside gatherings then there will be a Facebook live Storytime instead. Adult programming will also be out on the lawn. The classes will be held on Thursdays with the program being announced the Monday before. There will be stations already put together to maintain social distancing while still creating together. If the weather is not permitting, classes will be moved to the following week.
